Nevera Finswimming Cup

Rijeka (Croatia), 15 – 16 November 2025



PROPOSITIONS

1. VENUE

The competition will take place at Bazeni Kantrida swimming pool, located in Rijeka (Croatia), Podkoludricu street 2. The swimming pool is 50 m long, 2.25 m deep, with 10 lanes. It will be equipped with electronic time-keeping tables.

2. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION

Only individuals and teams from clubs members of federations affiliated to CMAS have the right to participate. To register, participants have to submit the following:

1. Medical certificate, not older than 6 months
2. Statement of responsibility, signed
3. A test for Scuba tanks, for immersion only
4. Confirmation of entry fee payment

3. ENTRIES

Entry list with competitor times by discipline should be sent by e-mail to rknevera@gmail.com

Final entry deadline is 9 November 2025.

The start list will be published on www.finswimmingnevera.com on 13 November 2025.

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is 30 € for each participant and it's payable at competition site in cash.

5. CATEGORIES

The competition is for juniors [C, B], seniors [A] and masters [M], both male and female. Younger participants [D] may compete under the junior category [C]. There are no limits to the number of individual races or the number of participants for each club.

6. AWARDS

The three best competitors in each discipline in the junior [C, B], senior [A] and masters [M] category will be awarded with medals.

7. START

Starting lists may be changed at discretion by the organizer during the event. Both preliminary and final start lists will be published on www.finswimmingnevera.com

8. COMPLAINTS

Complaints should be written and addressed to the main judge no more than 30 minutes after the fact. With every complaint 40 € must be paid in advance – this amount will be refunded in case of positive solution, otherwise the amount will be kept by the organizer.

9. RESPONSIBILITY

The Croatian Diving Federation and Nevera Diving Club as organizers of the competition aren't responsible for any damage consequent this competition. Each competitor will take part at his own risk as stated and signed in the Statement of responsibility.

10. EQUIPMENT

Compressed air cylinder [bottle] used for immersion must have a valid certificate, comply CMAS regulations and fulfil DIN and INT standards. The pressure may be up to 200 bars, with a minimal capacity of 0.5 liters.

11. RULES

Competition will be held upon the official CMAS and Croatian Diving Federation (HRS) Finswimming rules.

12. TIME LIMITS

For the following disciplines we have instated time limits: 800 m SF women 10:00,00; 800 m SF men 9:30,00.

13. MASTERS RELAY LINEUP

For the discipline 4 x 100 surface bifins mix, the relay in the masters category can be composed of two women and two men or three women and one man.
